Moved by Engels, seconded by Shook, to approve agenda. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Shook, seconded by Nolz, to approve the minutes from May 13, May 26, 2026 meetings. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Shook, seconded by Nolz, to approve May 2026 financial reports and June 2026 bill listing. Carried unanimously.
