Moved by Bixby, seconded by Lund, to approve agenda. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Endelman, seconded by Bixby, to approve the minutes from April 4 & April 11, 2022 meetings. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Endelman, seconded by Lund, to approve April 2022 financial reports and May 2022 bill listing. Carried unanimously.

Kim Marshall addressed the board regarding her current assignment within the district. She would like to go back to food service director only at \$35,590, single health insurance and 200 contract days.

Public hearing on issuance of approximately \$2,750,000 sales tax bonds was called to order at 6:16 p.m. No public response was received. The meeting was closed at 6:17 p.m.

Moved by Bixby, seconded by Lund, to approve the engagement letter with Ahlers & Cooney PC, bond counsel. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Endelman, seconded by Bixby, to increase the TAG FTE from .4 to .6. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Bixby, seconded by Endelman, to approve audit bid for five years from Nolte, Cornman & Johnson. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Bixby, seconded by Endelman, to approve the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with NIACC for regional vocational academy. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Endelman, seconded by Bixby, to approve the purchase of football field play clocks from H2I Group for \$9,020. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Endelman, seconded by Bixby, to approve the purchase of 35 Chromebooks from Dell for \$9,274.30. Carried unanimously.
