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2024 North Butler Annual Community Report on Progress on State Indicators

North Butler School District is committed to ensuring that all students make progress towards proficiency on state indicators. Student progress is shared out in seven main areas listed below.

#1 Proficiency of all 4th, 8th, and 11th grade students achieving PROFICIENT or higher **READING (ELA)** status using at least three achievement levels and by gender, race, socioeconomic status, students with disabilities, and other subgroups required by state or federal law.

#2 Proficiency of all 4th, 8th, and 11th grade students achieving PROFICIENT or higher **MATH** status using at least three achievement levels and by gender, race, socioeconomic status, students with disabilities, and other subgroups required by state or federal law.

- ☐ Per the North Butler Jr/Sr High School 2024-2025 Student Handbook, p.9, all graduating seniors from North Butler must complete 8 semesters (4 years) of English; 6 semesters (3 years) of Mathematics; 6 semesters (3 years) of Science; and 6 semesters (3 years) of Social Studies.
 - ☐ Based on that criteria, 100% of North Butler Graduating Students complete a core program of 4 years of English Language Arts (ELA) and 3 or more years each of mathematics, science, and social studies.

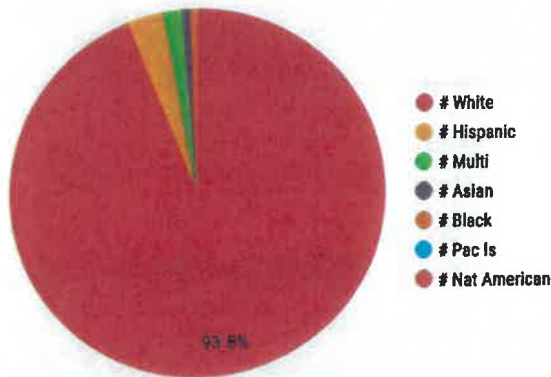
